

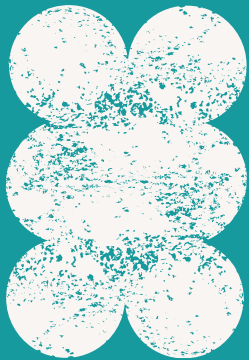


SENIOR CO-OP TRIP
